- This vacuum consists of a motorised nozzle. wand, and handheld vacuum. These components contain electrical connections, electrical wiring, and moving parts that potentially present risk to the user.
- Before each use, carefully inspect all parts for any damage. If a part is damaged discontinue use.
- Use only identical replacement parts.
- This vacuum contains no serviceable parts.
- Use only as described in this manual. **DO NOT** use the vacuum for any purpose other than those described in this manual.
- With the exception of the filters and dust cup, DO NOT expose any parts of the vacuum to water or other liquids
- **DO NOT** allow the appliance to be used by children. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children. Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close supervision is necessary when used near children.

GENERAL USE

- This appliance can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance should not be done by children.
- Always turn off the vacuum before connecting or disconnecting any current carrying hoses, motorised nozzles, chargers, batteries, or other electrical or mechanical parts.
- DO NOT handle plug or vacuum with wet hands.
- DO NOT use without dust cup, filters, and brush-
- Only use Shark® branded filters and accessories. Damage caused by non-Shark filters and accessories may not be covered by the quarantee.
- DO NOT put any objects into nozzle or accessory openings. DO NOT use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce airflow.
- **DO NOT** use if nozzle or accessory airflow is restricted. If the air paths or the motorised floor nozzle become blocked, turn the vacuum off. Remove all obstructions before you turn on the unit again.
- Keep nozzle and all vacuum openings away from hair, face, fingers, uncovered feet, or loose
- **DO NOT** use if vacuum is not working as it should, or has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- DO NOT leave the vacuum unattended while powered on.
- When powered on, keep the vacuum moving over the carpet surface at all times to avoid damaging the carpet fibres.

- Turn off the vacuum before plugging in or unplugging the charger. 23
- Turn off the vacuum before any adjustment, cleaning, maintenance or troubleshooting.
- During cleaning or routine maintenance, **DO NOT** cut anything other than 25 hair, fibres, or string wrapped around the brush-roll.
- Allow all filters to air-dry completely before replacing in the vacuum to prevent liquid from being drawn into electric parts.
- **DO NOT** modify or attempt to repair the vacuum or the battery yourself, except as indicated in this manual.
 - **DO NOT** use the battery or vacuum if it has been modified or damaged. Damaged or modified batteries may exhibit unpredictable behavior resulting in fire, explosion or risk of injury.
- Turn off all controls before unplugging. 28
- Always turn off this appliance before connecting 29 or disconnecting motorised nozzle or hand tool.

BATTERY PACK

- The battery is the power source for the vacuum. Carefully read and follow all charging instructions.
- To prevent unintentional starting, ensure the vacuum is powered off before picking up or carrying the vacuum. **DO NOT** carry the appliance with your finger on the power switch.
- Use only the charger supplied with the unit. Use of an incorrect charger may result in no charging, and/or unsafe conditions. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another battery pack.
- Keep the battery away from all metal objects such as paper clips, coins, keys, nails, or screws. Shorting the battery terminals increases the risk of fire or burns.

- 34 Under abusive conditions, liquid may be ejected from the battery. Avoid contact with this liquid, as it may cause irritation or burns. If contact occurs, flush with water. If liquid contacts eyes, seek medical help.


QUICK START GUIDE

How to set up the Shark IZ400 Cordless Vacuum with Anti-Odour Technology, Clean Sense IQ and Anti-Hair Wrap Plus.


SETTING UP YOUR UNIT

- 1. Insert Wand into Floor Nozzle
- Insert Handheld Vacuum into Wand.
- 3. Remove Anti-Odour Technology Dial from the tin. Flip up the dial handle, align the teal arrows, then insert the dial into the nozzle.
- Once read, remove the pealable stickers from the floor nozzle and the hand vacuum digital display.


Before use, ensure all components are completely connected and clicked into place. Please note, stickers on the floor head for the clean indicator and on the hand vacuum display screen are peelable and should be removed.






NOTE: The unit will not turn on if the charger is connected. Unplug the charger before turning on vacuum power



Press the (4) button to toggle between ECO, Clean Sense IQ, and Boost modes. To save battery power, select ECO mode. For everyday cleaning power, select Clean Sense IQ mode. For an extra burst of power, select Boost



The Clean Indicator visually confirms when floors are clean. When the unit senses heavy debris, suction will increase for more cleaning power. When the debris is cleared, suction will decrease. The light bar displays the suction level, and will increase or decrease as the suction power changes.



Flip up the handle and rotate the Anti-Odour dial to adjust Anti-Odour Technology intensity or to unlock the dial for cartridge access.

ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE

CLEANING THE FILTERS

Regularly rinse and reinstall the filters to maintain your vacuum's suction power and to maximise the effectiveness of the odour cartridge.

To clean filters, rinse them with water only. Allow all filters to air-dry completely for up to 48 hours before reinstalling, to prevent liquid from being drawn into electric parts.

Clean the pre-motor filters at least once a month and post-motor filter at least once a year. Tap off loose dirt between washes when needed. More frequent cleaning may sometimes be necessary with heavy use.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT use soap when cleaning the filters. Use water only. The vacuum will not have suction if the post-motor filter is not installed. Ensure that all filters are installed before using.

CLEANING THE CLEAN SENSE IQ SENSORS

If the Clean Sense IQ sensors are dirty, the nozzle light bar will flash and the vacuum will operate in a standard power setting until sensors are cleaned. Clean using a microfibre cloth.
